## **2005 FOUNDATION SEED ORDERING INFORMATION**

### **PRIORITIES IN PROCESSING ORDERS FOR FOUNDATION SEED**

1. Advance orders received by March 15, 2004 accompanied by a down payment received first priority on available seed.
2. Orders placed between March 15 and December 15, 2004 received second priority. For varieties where demand exceeded the supply, seed was prorated.
3. For varieties still available, orders received after December 15, 2004 are being filled in the sequence received.

### **SEED LOT INFORMATION**

1. Contact Roger or Craig if you want more information about a Foundation seed lot.
2. Testing has not been completed on all lots at this time.
3. Bulk or bulk bags may be available for some varieties. Call MCIA for details.

### **PAYMENT POLICY**

#### **RETURN YOUR CONFIRMATION/ORDER FORM WITH YOUR PAYMENT BY FEBRUARY 15, 2005**

1. Payment for seed must be made in full prior to picking up seed.
2. If you prefer a specific location, please include full payment; otherwise, orders will be assigned to the nearest available location.
3. Full payment is due March 15, 2005 and arrangements for pickup or shipment must be made by April 1, 2005.
4. Upon receipt of full payment, you will receive a receipt indicating your pick up location.

### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

If all or part of an order is cancelled, 25% of the payment for the cancelled order will be forfeited unless an alternate customer is found for the seed or the amount cancelled is substituted by an equal amount of another variety of the same crop. New varieties cannot be used to substitute for cancelled orders.

### **ADVANCE ORDERS FOR 2006**

If you want to be sure a variety you need will be available, consider an advance order. To place an order for seed for 2006 planting, call MCIA for the Special Advance Order Form. Advance orders received by March 15, 2005 and accompanied by a 25% down payment will have first priority on available seed in 2006.
